

#### Veterinary Care

The Veterinary Relief Fund has been created to help low-income families care for their pets by offering help with both Urgent and Preventative Veterinary Care.

Urgent Care Funds are for those who need emergency for life saving care. The typical grant is up to \$300.00.

Preventative Care Funds help animals who need regular vaccines, rabies vaccines or a month of maintenance medication. The typical grant is up to \$70.00 for vaccines and up to \$100.00 for medication.

To qualify, a recommendation from the veterinarian outlining the care needed, an estimated cost, and potential prognosis for the animal is required.
